The Arkansas Arts Center announces a call for entries for its 45th annual Young Arkansas Artists exhibition. Twelve artworks per grade level (K-12) will be exhibited in the Arkansas Arts Center March 24 - May 21, 2006.

A juror will select a \$200 "Best of Class" and two \$100 "Honorable Mention" awards for each grade level (K-12).

To support the funding of art programs, awards will be given to the school art department in honor of the winning student.

AWARDS SPONSOR



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SELECTION OF EXHIBITION

All entries will be judged based on originality and artistic merit by members of the Arkansas Art Education Association. The top twelve works per grade level will be included in the exhibition. The Arkansas Arts Center will appoint a professional, objective juror for the selection of prize awards. For each grade level, \$200 will be awarded for the work selected as the "Best of Class" and \$100 will be awarded for each of the two works selected for "Honorable Mention". These monetary awards will be given to the school art departments in honor of the winning student.

TRAVELING EXHIBITIONS

The curatorial staff of the Arkansas Arts Center will select 75 of the exhibited works for Traveling Exhibitions. Three-dimensional objects and large-scale works cannot be circulated in the traveling exhibitions due to shipping restrictions. The chosen works will be exhibited in classrooms the following year. A selection of these works will also be exhibited at Arkansas Children's Hospital. Some artworks may be on loan to the Arkansas Arts Center for up to two years, until September 2008. HOW TO ENTER

Complete one ENTRY FORM per school. List each artwork individually. Please print clearly and make sure names and titles are spelled correctly.

Photocopy the IDENTIFICATION LABEL and complete one label for each artwork. Attach label to the upper left corner on the back of each work. Attach label to sculpture with string.

RULES

Works in all media are eligible—including drawings, paintings, prints, photographs, collages, crafts and sculpture. Works should be made during the current school year. They must be original—that is, not directly copied from a published photograph, magazine or book illustration or any other artwork.

Open to all Arkansas students, Kindergarten through 12th grade. Submissions must be made through a public or private school teacher or an instructor of an art program. The teacher/instructor may submit only one piece per grade level. An official entry form must be submitted by the school or art program.

Group projects may be submitted as a single entry for the average grade level of the students. Remember, only one artwork per grade level is permitted. Attach an alphabetical list of names for group projects on a separate sheet and attach to Entry Form. Please list only students who contributed to making the artwork.

Minimum Mat Size: 20 X 28 INCHES. Mats should be exactly 20 x 28 inches to be considered for the traveling exhibition.

All works on paper must be securely mounted in standard white mat board or poster board. No frames or colored mats are allowed for works on paper. This rule aids in the fair judging of the work.

Works must have a solid foamcore or cardboard backing. Each work must be rigid enough to stand alone while leaning against a wall.

Paintings on canvas or board should be framed for presentation.

Any work that hangs on a wall can be no larger than 96 x 96 inches.

Three-dimensional work must fit on a floor display platform (48 x 96 inches) or table-top platform (36 x 96 inches). The Arkansas Arts Center will provide pedestals for the exhibition of sculpture.

DELIVERY

Entries should be received by Tuesday, February 14, 2006. We are closed to the public on Mondays, but we will accept deliveries from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on February 13th in the lower lobby. Please call ahead to make arrangements for delivery of large sculpture. Please do not attach any payment or return postage at this time.
