Mini-grant Conditions & Restrictions

The following conditions and restrictions apply to the Arkansas Science & Technology Authority Minigrant. By accepting the grant, teachers and their principals agree to these conditions and restrictions.

- Mini-grant funds must be expended in one year from award date.
- Teachers awarded a Mini-grant must complete a final report at the end of the grant period. The final report must indicate the effect that the Mini-grant had on teaching the material and on student performance.
- The school principal must sign the final report indicating that the Mini-grant funds were used by students for hands-on classroom experiences of science principles.
- Mini-grant funds must be used only for consumable materials used for classroom demonstrations. Mini-grant funds cannot be used to purchase textbooks or other paper products.
- Mini-grant funds may be used to purchase science preparation kits like those constructed by the National Science Foundation. All kits must be standardsbased and support the Arkansas frameworks for a specific grade.
- Mini-grant awardees must keep a record and receipts of purchases. Receipts must accompany the final report.
- Mini-grant awardees must administer a pre- and post-test to their students at the beginning and end of the academic period in which the Mini-grant support materials were used. This test will be provided by the Authority. A copy of the pre- and post-test must be submitted with the test results at the end of the grant period. Test results must be coded by the teacher to maintain student confidentiality. Participating schools will also remain confidential. The Authority will compare test results to measure the academic impact of the grants.
- Applications must be received no later than 4:30 p.m., June 14, 2002.
