• Eligibility Requirements – An Arkansas resident, male or female, who is a member of, or has been a member of, an Arkansas 4-H Club, FCCLA, FBLA or FFA Chapter and who has exhibited a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place item in the Junior Creative Arts Department at the Agricultural Fairs in the State of Arkansas and the Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show is eligible to apply for these scholarships. The applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and must provide verification of an ACT score of no less than 18 with application. Applicant must be enrolled, or will enroll for Fall 2006 or Spring 2007 semester, in a college or university. Applicant should have and present evidence of leadership abilities and economic need. Applicant may not have been a previous recipient of any Arkansas State Fair scholarship, and is eligible for only one award.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT

- 1. Attach to the completed original of this application the following required material:
 - a. Certified copy of your high school transcript with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
 - b. Certified copy of an ACT Score of 18 or above.
 - c. Certified copy of your college transcript (if at least one semester has been completed).
- 2. A typewritten application is preferred except where handwriting is specified. You can complete the typed portions online and then print for signatures, handwork and mailing. Review the application carefully to determine that you have fully answered all questions and signed the application. Unsigned or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. No additional pages may be used to answer questions. The only picture allowed will be a school type photo on the cover page. No additional pictures or news clippings will be accepted.

This single application will be considered for all three scholarships available:

- Witt Stephens Creative Arts Scholarships The two (2) Witt Stephens Creative Arts Scholarships will be \$2,500 payable \$1,250 per semester upon official verification from the Registrar of the college of the college or university after the applicant enrolls. They will be granted to a full time student carrying 12 hours or more. Second semester grant will be made upon verification of a minimum 3.0 GPA (4 point system) for student's previous semester's total hours and enrollment verification.
- Maurice Smith Scholarship The Maurice Smith Scholarship will be \$500 payable in full upon official verification from the Registrar of the college or university after the applicant enrolls. It will be granted to a full time student carrying 12 hours or more. Both Livestock and Creative Arts Exhibitors will compete for one \$500 Maurice Smith Scholarship.

Scholarships will be awarded to a graduating high school senior or an upperclassman, and will be awarded in the order of value, based on the total score per applicant. Recipient must request disbursement of funds within one year of award.


