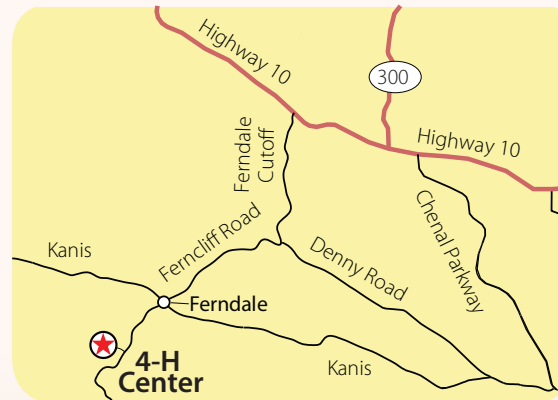
Directions:

From I-430:

Take the Cantrell/Highway 10 exit and travel west. Follow Highway 10 for 8.5 miles. Turn left onto Ferndale Cutoff (West Pulaski Fire Department will be on the right). Follow Ferndale Cutoff 5 miles to stop sign in Ferndale. Travel another 1.1 miles on Ferndale Cutoff. The 4-H center will be on the right.

From I-30:

Take the Congo Road exit (in Benton) and travel north. Turn left at the stop sign in Salem. Take a right at the "Y" of Mulberry Road and Congo Road. Take a right at the "Y" of Steel Bridge Road and Congo Road. Continue to the 4-H center, which is on the left. Total distance from I-30 is 17 miles. Watch for signs.



Deadline to register is October 13.

There is no fee for the training but registration is limited to 250 on a first-come, first-registered basis.
