Meg Wheatley To Address The "Challenges of Communities"

Meg Wheatley will address the "Challenge of Communities" at the 2000 AASCD Summer Conference. Dr. Wheatley was recently asked to comment on the challenge of creating a vibrant community, she wrote:

"Today so many of our communities and the institutions that serve them are lost because they lack clarity about why they are together. Few schools know what the community wants of them; the same is true for health care, government, and the military. Most of us don't feel as if we are members of a community; we just live or work next to each other. Without agreements about why we belong together, our instincts lead us to a community of 'me,' not a community of 'we.'

To achieve higher levels of greatness, we need to begin conversations about purpose and shared significance-- Who are we? and What matters? --and commit to staying in them. As this occurs, we will start to work together rather than convince each other who has more truth."

### Meet Meg Wheatley

Margaret Wheatley is president of The Berkana Institute, and an internationally acclaimed speaker and writer. She has been an organizational consultant and researcher since 1973; prior to that time, she served as a public school teacher and urban education administrator, and a Peace Corps volunteer in Korea. She also has been Associate Professor of Management at the Marriott School of Management, Brigham Young University, and Cambridge College, Massachusetts.

Dr. Wheatley received her doctorate from Harvard University's program in Administration, Planning and Social Policy. She holds a M.A. in Communications and Systems Thinking from New York University, and has also been a research associate at Yale University. She is a fellow of the World Business Academy and an advisor to The Fetzer Institute's Fellows Program.
